Program of Activities

Day 1.

Welcome! Reception and accommodation of the participants. Icebreaking games, planning of the objectives for the exchange. First local visits.

Day 2.

Welcome at the City Hall of La Victoria de Acentejo. Workshop: Where are you from? Night of percussion music at the beach.

Day 3.

Visit to La Laguna, World Heritage Site by the UNESCO and University of La Laguna. Orientation game "Europe is a treasure".

Day 4.

Visit to Tenerife South - paradise for tourism and its environmental problems and immigration, but still a place worth to visit. Discussion about immigration problems in Europe and the example of the Canary Islands. Organized games related to the topic.

"A demon as a volcano" - Visit to Teide volcano. The volcanic origin of the Canary Islands. Guided tour, and adventure sports. International dinner.

Day 6.

Visit to Santa Cruz of Tenerife, capital of the island and home of the canary Parliament. Explanation of the regional political structure. Guided visit to Anaga forest - the last prehistoric forest. Workshop- discussion: supranational versus local culture. Night workshop: the carnival in Tenerife.

Day 7.

"The last Europe" - trip to El Hierro Island - the last occidental part of Europe and protected biosphere site. Discussion of the problems associated. Workshop- discussion: the environmental problems of Europe.

Day 8.

Visits to the island's sea resources. Sport activities at the beach. Return back to Tenerife.

Day 9.

Agricultural landscape of the Canaries and visits to different parts of the island. Discussion: the protection of the EU and its consequences.
